

## SCHOOL OF LAW

**ITEM: AC 29-A- 06: To discuss and ratify the syllabi of Ph.D scholars course work in the School of Law.**

*The Vice-Chancellor, as Chairman of Academic Council had approved the syllabi of Ph.D course work of School of law which was recommended by the Board of Studies of School of law. The Ph.D scholars of School of Law should undergo the following courses :*

1. *Research Methodology – Common for all*
2. *Any one paper from List-1, which consists of 10 core subjects of Law*
3. *Another paper to be taken from List II, which consists of 10 specialized papers of Law.*

*It is also recommended that papers in List II be revised after every 3 years. It is further proposed to conduct Research Methodology course work for Ph.D scholars of School of Law at the school level along with other two papers but final examinations will be conducted by the Controller of Examinations. The detailed syllabi is given in **Annexure –V**.*

**“Resolved that the approved syllabi of Ph.D coursework of the School of Law is ratified.”**

## SCHOOL OF BIOTECHNOLOGY

**ITEM: AC 29-A- 07: To report the approval of the research methodology syllabus for Ph.D scholars of the School of Biotechnology.**

*The syllabi of Ph.D course work of School of Biotechnology as approved by the Vice-Chancellor as Chairman of Academic Council is placed before the Council for ratification. (**Annexure- VI**.)*

The Council suggested to correct the typographical errors of elective subject to Compulsory subject in the course structure of syllabus. The evaluation system also to be standardized in the line of the University rules. The Council suggested the Director, KSBT to change the syllabus accordingly in consultation with Chairman, Research and submit the syllabus to the Vice-Chancellor for approval.
