ITEM: AC 29-B- 49: To consider revisiting course sequencing across 3rd and 4th semester of MBA (RM) programme.

The Director, KSRRM proposed to shift 2 core courses namely Strategic Management and Strategic Marketing offered in Semester 4 to 3rd semester in place of courses like Human Resource Development and ICT for Development for better career opportunities of the students.

The Minutes of the Board of Studies held on 10th March, 2016 is placed before the council as Annexure XLVIII.

The Council instructed that shuffling of courses in between different semesters is a school level decision and it should not come to the Council for approval in future.
