BLOOD DONATION CAMP

Blood donation is one of the most significant contribution that a person can make towards the society. It is not harmful for an adult person to donate blood. The body of the donor can regenerate the blood within few days. It poses no threat to the metabolism of the body. With this thought the National Service Scheme, KIIT School of Biotechnology organized a blood donation camp on 24th of July, 2019 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.

The camp was inaugurated by NSS Bureau head, Dr. Kajal Parashar and NSS Programme officer of School of Biotechnology(KIIT), Dr. Prabhat Rout. In this camp overwhelming number of volunteers of different departments of KIIT University has participated with vivacity. All the preparations such as arrangement of beds, sanitation etc were made. A team of doctors and nurses from Kalinga Institute of Medical Sciences (KIMS) had reached on time at the venue.



- At first the weights of the donors were measured. One of the rooms was utilized for a thorough medical check-up of potential donors.
- As well as the donation was also going on itself, there was another hall where medical team were taking blood and taking care of blood donors.
- After that they were shifted to an another room where donors could lie down and recuperate for a while before they leave venue.
- The process took almost fifteen-twenty minutes.
- After donation they were provided with refreshments such as fruit juice, biscuits, banana, sandwich, Egg & some sweets.
- The blood samples were carefully collected, sealed and transported away by medical team of KIMS.



The audience were acknowledged that the donated blood would be used for saving the lives of the injured and the sick. One of the doctors also addressed the audience saying that the blood donation does not weaken the body of the donors. The recovery takes place very soon. He talked about facts and myths about blood groups related information. More than 65 students along with faculty members and NSS Volunteers donated their blood
