

# **KISS TEACHING PROJECT**

We had started our KISS Teaching Project on January 2019. Basically the main motto of this project is to inculcate the vision of education among the students, though there are respective faculties

for teaching them, we support them as the real mentor to break the barrier between them with the outside world. We had taken the responsibility of teaching, for the class 8 & 9.

The Subjects that we are covering are:

- ✓ **English & Soft Skills**
- ✓ **Mathematics & GK**
- ✓ **Science**

We teach them for 2 hrs in the evening from 06:15 pm - 08:15 pm. Each class have two section, our volunteers take class in 4 sections. In Routine wise we daily cover a particular subject for both class 8 & 9.

## **Science**

- **TIME: 60 hours**

The NSS unit of KIIT University organized a project of teaching the students of Kalinga Institute Of Social Sciences (KISS). Under this project 3 different subject are taught: Maths and GK ; Science ; English and Soft skills.



Students of the Biotechnology department (KSBT) taught classes 8 and 9 of KISS. This project was made a success with the guidance of the principal and concerned faculties.

On the first day, students under the **science** group interacted with the students through games and also conducted quizzes. This was done to establish a good communication with the students. Students of each class 8 and 9 were each divided into groups of 2, consisting of 25 students each.

Through the quiz, games, and further interaction, the NSS volunteers got acquainted with the syllabus that needed to be taught. Many interesting facts and discoveries in the field of science was discussed with the students.

- **TIME: 60 Hours**

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day at KISS, the NSS volunteers under science group, discussed the science syllabus with the students. A brief overview was given to the students about the basic concepts of biology, physics and chemistry.



Two volunteers were assigned to each sections of classes 8 and 9.

The volunteers interacted with all of the students to ask them their doubts. Through further interactive sessions with the students their doubts on the basic concepts were cleared. Videos and photographic illustrations were used to further increase their interest in the subject.

In the end of the class, students were asked to summarize the concepts delivered. It was made sure that every student got equal attention during the teaching session.

- 15/08/19
- **TIME: 60 Hours**

Students of classes 8 and 9 were taught by the science volunteers under NSS. Each class 8 and 9 were divided into groups of 2 consisting of 50 students each.

Interactive sessions were conducted with the students to gradually draw their interest into the subject.

The topics that were covered in the last sessions were revised.



It was made sure that doubts of each student was cleared. The class was made interesting by demonstrations through photos and videos.

Chapters those needed explanation was covered in details.

Physical sciences and life sciences, both these areas were covered by the volunteers. Further, a short quiz session was conducted with questions from their syllabus.



## **English & Soft Skills**

 **TIME: 60 Hrs**

The main objective of this project is based on to provide some extra education (*Specially English speaking and soft skill classes* ). The Volunteers of the NSS unit had taught the children of the school of class 8.



### **We had conducted:**

The NSS volunteers had taught the students of Secondary School, class 8. They have been divided into 2 groups and each group was carrying 25 students. Firstly they have tried to be friendly with the students, so that they can be free with the volunteers.

They have taught English, How to give Introduction and some funny quiz game, word games between the students to improve their problem solving skills, and for making some unity between themselves, the volunteers are also helping them to build up their own personality to come out from their own world and be comfortable in the outside world.
