The team on the way, discussed the topics on which we were about to create awareness in Barang. The topic selected by the team was to make people aware about the Motor Vehicle Amendment Act 2019 that was implemented by the central government recently. The team reached Barang village at 8:15am. The aim of the visit was to tell the people to carry with them all the necessary documents that are required while they are driving any vehicle.

Many posters were made by the team members to tell the people about the traffic rules implemented, these included the comparison chart between fines that were imposed earlier vs those imposed now, the traffic symbols charts, a working traffic light was made for demonstration. People were also made aware of the Digi locker app that is provided by the government of India through which a person can show all his documents, and avoid any fines.

The whole team was divided into 4 groups, each group comprising an Odia volunteer for interaction purposes. The teams headed off to different parts of the village with their posters and slogan. Door-to-door interactions were done with the villagers. Each team created awareness among the villagers to follow traffic rules, how wearing helmets and seat belts are necessary for their own safety. Team also showed a video cautioning them about the result of not following traffic rules and how they could get into trouble. The team interacted with the children and played a game with them using the working model of the traffic light, in which they were taught when to stop, get ready and go on different colors of the light.

This whole awareness campaign lasted for 3 and a 1/2 hours at Barang. To have a record of the wonderful time NSS SCE volunteers spent in the village Barang, we clicked some photos with the village children who were hoisting the posters. Having spent a great time, the team NSS SCE volunteers again boarded their buses to head back to the college campus. The team reached college campus by 12 noon.
