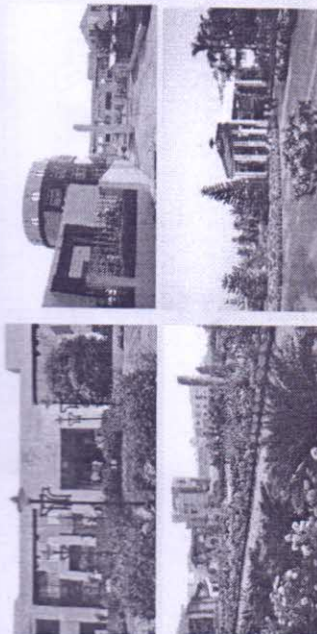

- Total number of slides should not exceed 15.
- Presenters are required to send the abstract to **cne@kins.ac.in** on or before **05 December 2020 (5:00 pm)**.
- Acceptance of abstract will be confirmed by **07 December 2020**.
